My job here is still the same, but lately I've been allowed more freedom in my schedule due to my time at the radar station. I've found a few comrades to keep me company here, they work similar positions. One is an MP and the other works at the radar station as a terminal operator. I'm actually printing this on their terminal so I can print it out on the automatic typewriter.

How are my sisters? Have they found work yet? I miss them dearly and I hope they are doing well. Last I heard, Ushara got into university. Is she doing well?
